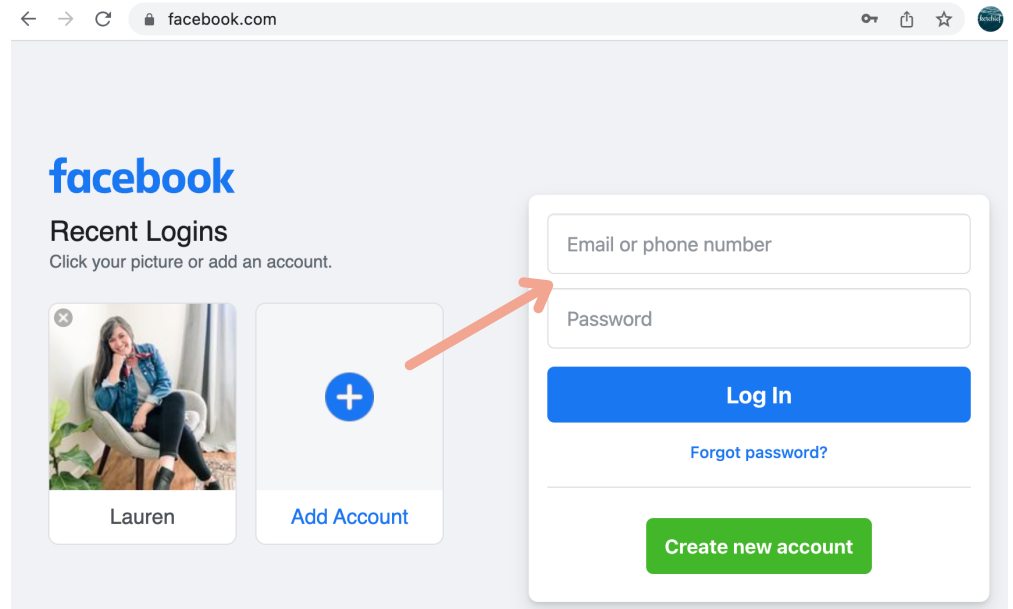
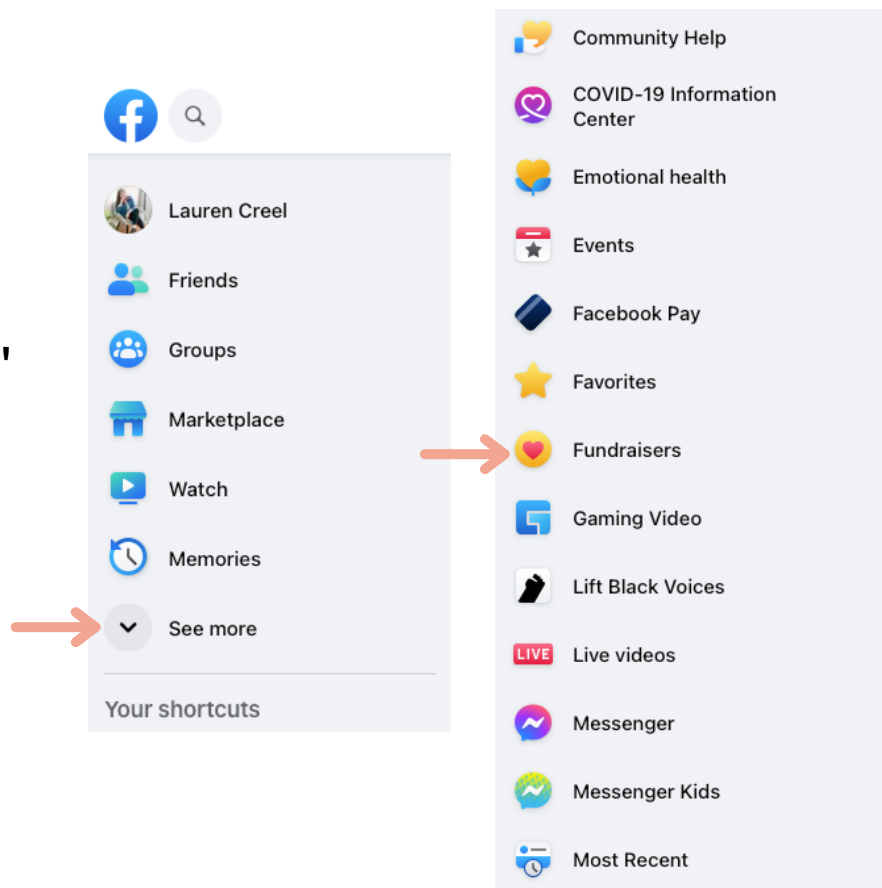


Start your own Cactus Cancer Society Facebook Fundraiser

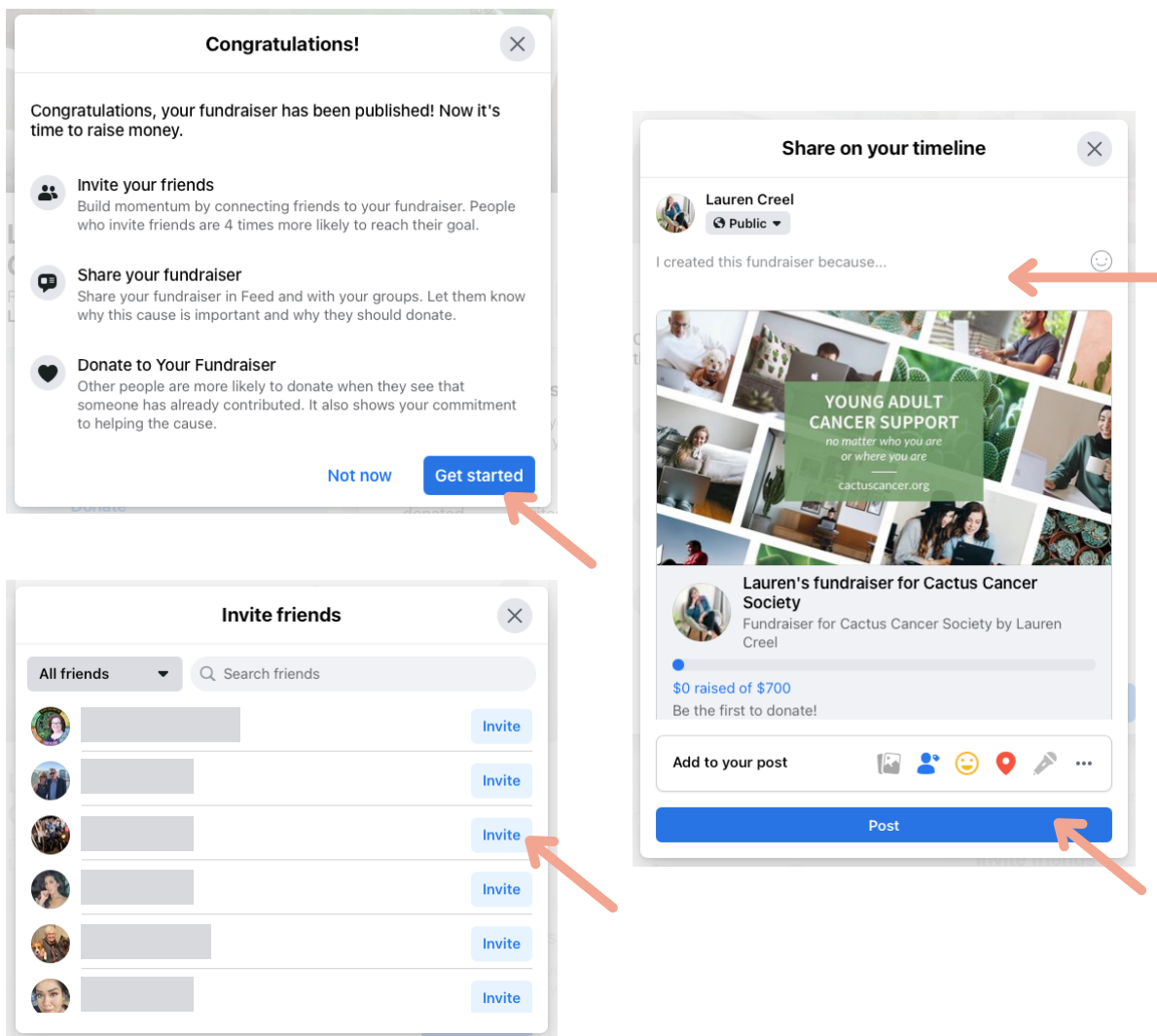

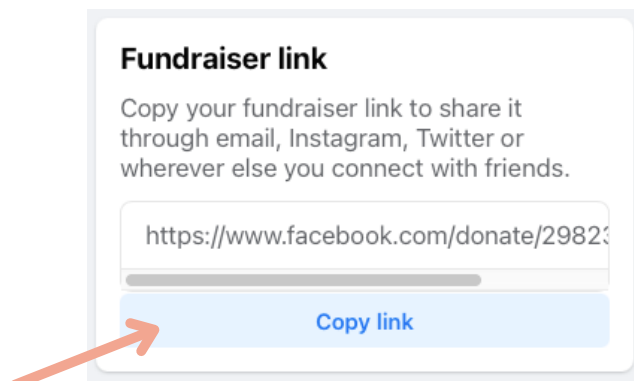




Want to send an email with a link to your fundraiser? Just scroll down on your Fundraiser page, click "Copy Link", and then paste the link into your email. Easy peasy!
